Required Materials:

- * Bring scissors, HB and 6B pencils
- * Acrylic paint is required from the start. You'll have watercolour options for later in the term
- * Oil paint ok for later in term
- * Colours - medium yellow, ultramarine and pthalo blue, Alizarin Crimson, yellow ochre, Cadmium Red, burnt umber, black, white - also ... include any of your favourite colours or brands
- * Brushes - mix of bristle and synthetic hair - from large 3 inch, medium 1 inch to small
- * Heavy cartridge paper for painting on. Panels or canvas for later in the term
- * Please note, we will discuss material needs at the beginning of the class
- * Brown paper is available and free
